- 4.1. Mode of study: Full-time study programme, equivalent to 120 ECTS including an internship
- 4.2. Programme learning outcomes: The graduate will be able to:

  - participate in professional and interdisciplinary cooperation with a professional approach in the fields of economics, business and financial law, intermediation and consulting
  - acquire new knowledge, skills and competencies in a structured context in relation to economics, business and financial law, intermediation and consulting
- 4.3. Programme details, individual credits gained and grades/marks obtained: The Financial Management programme complies with the curriculum for Financial Management according to the Executive Order No. 2673 of 28.12.2021 on Technical and Commercial Academy Profession Programmes and Bachelor Programmes of the Danish Ministry of Higher Education and Science. The programme combines theory and practice. The teaching methods alternate between theoretical tuition, lectures, exercises, cases and projects coupled with individual tutoring. The study programme consists of national educational elements (60 ECTS), local educational elements including electives and specialisation (30 ECTS), internship (15 ECTS) and a final examination project (15 ECTS).
